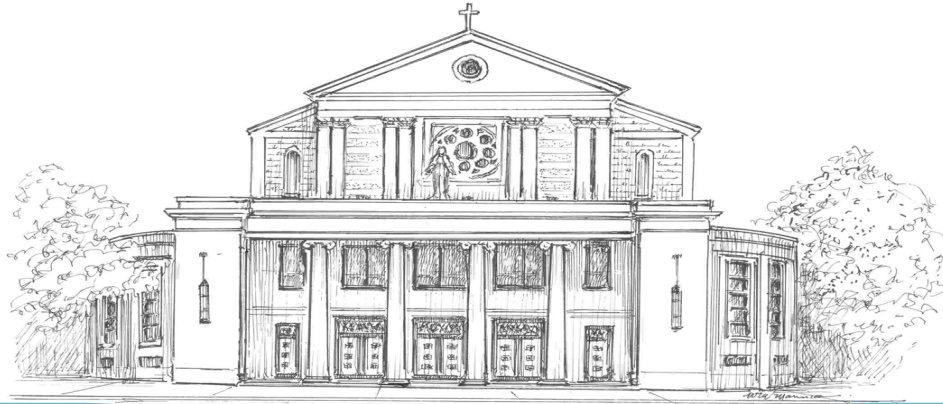

All Souls' Day

Today is a beautiful feast - a day to remember and pray for all those who have died. All of us have had people we love die - parents, children, brothers, sisters, grandparents, close friends and so many more. The pain of their loss never really completely disappears but today's feast reminds us of a beautiful way to remember them and their love. The best thing we can do for them is to never forget them and pray for them and ask them to pray for all. This is what it means when the church talks about the communion of saints.

In the preface for funeral Masses, the prayers remind us that in death "life is changed not ended." If we fail to understand this, then we are like the people spoken about in the first reading from the Book of Wisdom today. It says: "*The souls of the just are in the hand of God and no torment shall touch them. They seemed in the view of the foolish to be dead and their passing away was thought an affliction...but they are in peace.*"

Of course, when someone we love dies, we are filled with sadness and grief. The scriptures tell us that Jesus himself cried when he heard his friend Lazarus had died. But we are reminded by this feast that in the midst of grief, we can have hope, hope in the promise of eternal life and the fact that Jesus died for us to give us the gift of eternal life.

In the gospel today, Jesus says: "*This is the will of my Father, that everyone who sees the Son and believes in Him may have eternal life, and I shall raise him on the last day.*" We are promised that whoever believes in Jesus will have eternal life. Jesus reminds us it's not just something nice His Father thought of, it is his Father's will. Today, don't be like the foolish in the scriptures, take time to remember all those who have died; believe their lives are changed not ended; and pray for them that they have inherited the gift promised to us all - the gift of eternal life!

All Saints Day and All Souls Day are two special days in the Liturgical Year. They are not the most significant days but they are reminders to us of what we are called to do and what we are called to become.

All Saints Day gives us the example of the men and women who have gone before us and lived the Christian Life in such a way that we believe they are now in Heaven with our God. From their place in Heaven, they act as our intercessors taking our prayers to God on our behalf. That is why we pray to the Saints.

Beyond their role of intercessors, the saints are excellent role models to us on how to live the Christian life. I invite you to read some of the lives of the saints, especially those who lived close to our time. A wonderful book to read is *My Life with the Saints* by James Martin. In many ways it brings a new perspective on how we use the Saints in our lives.

All Souls Day reminds us that the people who we loved in this life and have gone before us are not forgotten. On All Souls Day we pray to and for our beloved deceased. At the Noon Mass today, I will read the names of everyone who had a funeral celebrated in our parish since last All Souls Day. A candle with their name is also prepared and will be lit during this Mass. The candles will be used in our Adoration Chapel throughout the coming year. In that way we continue the memory of our loved ones throughout the coming year. May we always pray for our beloved deceased.

And Let Perpetual Light Shine Upon Them!
