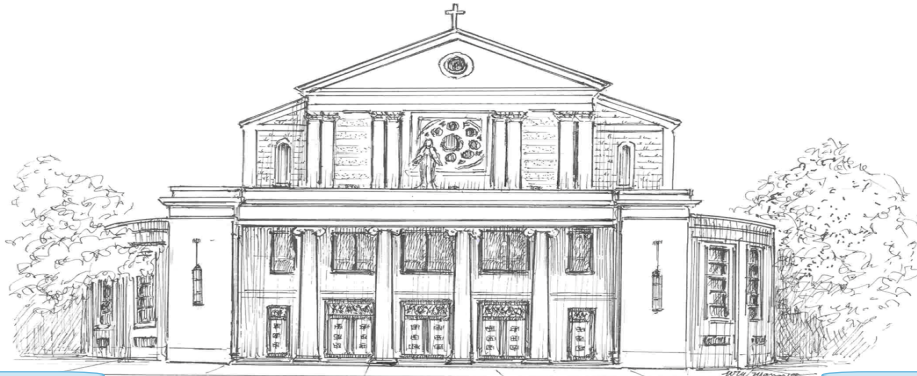

Rosary for Life

On Friday, January 22nd, thousands will gather in Washington D.C. for the March for Life. Although Saint William Parish will not be sending a bus to the event we will still participate in the spirit of the day. As I see it, we can do several things to participate remotely. The first thing that I think we can do is watch it on television from the warmth and comfort of our home. I believe that EWTN airs the Mass from the National Shrine in the morning. I think that we can support what happens in Washington by sacrificing what we would normally be watching or doing at that time and offer that time up for the sake of the unborn.

The second thing that we can do is attend the Rosary for Life that will be prayed at Saint William Church at 7:00 PM. As was announced last week, it will be multi-lingual. Each decade of the Rosary will be prayed in the following languages; 1) English, 2) Spanish, 3) Creole, 4) Urdu, and 5) Vietnamese. The Rosary will be followed by Exposition of the Blessed Sacrament, a brief reading from Scripture with a reflection, concluding with Benediction.

The evening Rosary should be over within an hour. Please make every effort to come and pray for a deeper respect for the sanctity of all life from conception to natural death.
