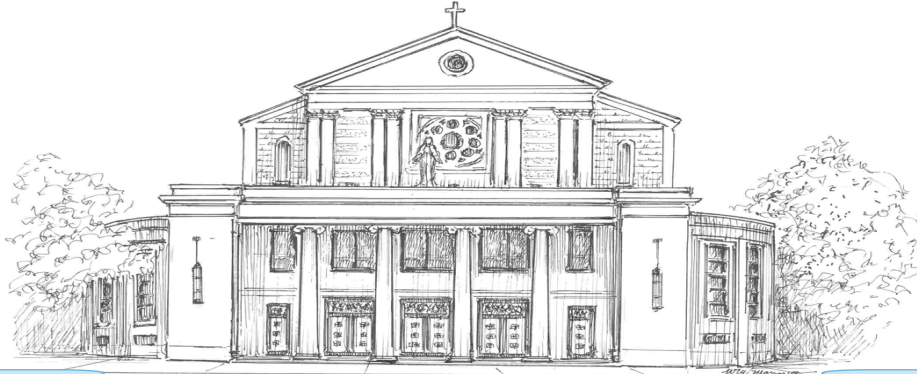

From the desk of Fr. Joe...

Fifty Years of Priesthood

On this Pentecost Sunday we celebrate the gift of the Holy Spirit upon the Church. In fact, today is referred to as the birthday of the Church. We see in the Scripture accounts that the Spirit descended upon the Apostles and empowered them to continue the ministry of Jesus Christ.

With the help and guidance of the Holy Spirit that ministry continues today. The ministry of Jesus takes many forms in the Church and many people share in that ministry in various ways. Today, however, I would like to acknowledge one ministry and one minister.

Father Edward B. Connolly celebrated his First Mass at Saint William Church on May 22, 1966. His ordination to the Priesthood was the day before on May 21st.

When Father Connolly was a boy of 13 in 1951 his family moved into our parish. His parents were Francis and Pauline Connolly. Fr. Connolly had an older brother who also celebrated his First Mass at Saint William in 1959, the late Msgr. Francis X. Connolly. Both were priests of the Allentown Diocese.

Fr. Connolly wished to come home to his "old parish church" to celebrate his Golden Jubilee, and so, he will celebrate the Noon Mass next Sunday, exactly 50 years to the day. Even fifty years later there are still family connections to Saint William. His three sisters are Anne Connolly Zielinski, Regina Connolly O'Reilly and Therese Connolly. Current parishioners will, perhaps, be acquainted with the Mark and Gina Grimaldi family on Argyle Street. Gina is one of Fr. Connolly's fifteen nieces and nephews, all of whom have their roots in St. William's.

As we celebrate Fr. Connolly's fifty years of priestly service to the Church, let us pray for more vocations to the priesthood and religious life.
