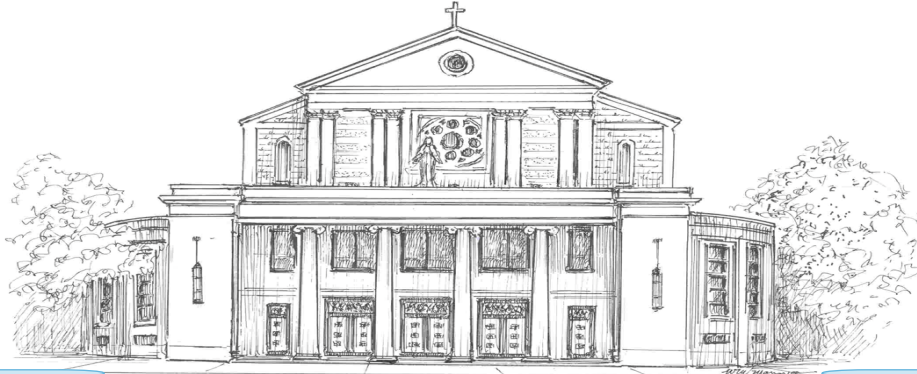

Participating in a Marriage Preparation Program is a requisite for the reception of this holy sacrament.
