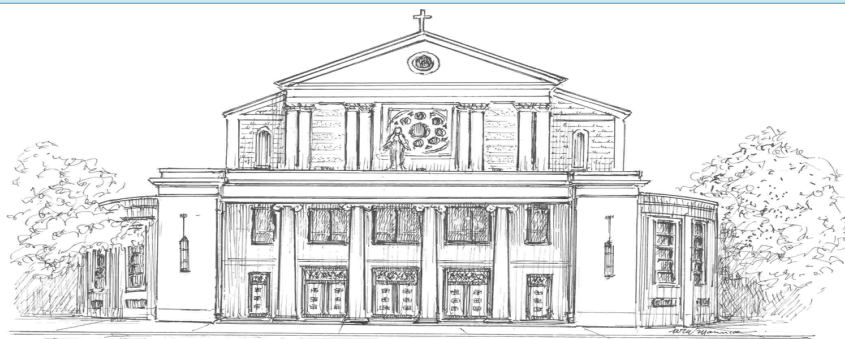

### **Independence Day 2016**

*As we approach Independence Day, let us remember the past and celebrate every year the Lord's Blessing upon us.*

*We celebrate American Independence Day on the Fourth of July every year. We think of July 4, 1776, as a day that represents the Declaration of Independence and the birth of the United States of America as an independent nation. But July 4, 1776 wasn't the day that the Continental Congress decided to declare independence (they did that on July 2, 1776). It wasn't the day we started the American Revolution either (that had happened back in April 1775).*

*So what did happen on July 4, 1776? The Continental Congress approved the final wording of the Declaration of Independence on July 4, 1776. They'd been working on it for a couple of days after the draft was submitted on July 2<sup>nd</sup> and finally agreed on all of the edits and changes. July 4, 1776, became the date that was included on the Declaration of Independence.*

*Let us take this opportunity to beg to God for our country and for people everywhere who enjoy the freedoms we all have received. Please join us for the 9:00 AM Mass on July 4, 2016 at St. William.*

*Let us pray: God has placed lessons in our everyday life that teach us new things or remind us of important things. Just as we stumbled into the lightning bug lessons, so you too are witnesses each day to insights from God's creation.*

*Asking the Lord to nudge us when we are in the midst of a heavenly revelation helps prepare us to be aware and watchful.*
