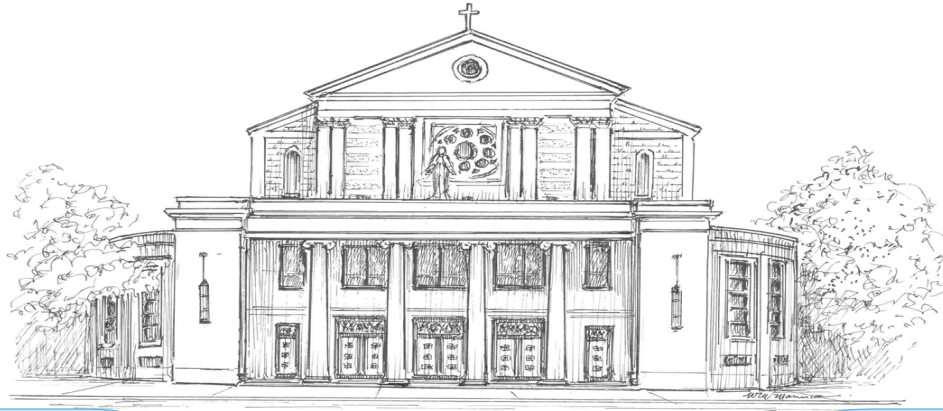

Twenty-Seventh Sunday in Ordinary Time

Did you ever feel as if God is trying to get your attention? We are very busy each day about many things; our jobs, our children, our spouses. We might say a quick prayer in the morning when we get up or at night before bed. We are not ignoring God. After all, all these things are important. Life is not always easy and demands our time and attention. Perhaps though it might be good for us to stop and remember someone can help us with all these important things.

Isaiah, in the first reading today tells the story of a vineyard owner who does all the right thing for his vineyard to be successful but for some reason, all that results is wild grapes, good for nothing. Jesus, in the gospel today tells the parable of the landowner who leases his vineyard to others but when he asks for the return, they beat some of his servants, stone another and even kill his son. Both scripture passages refer to the Israelites, the chosen people. Like the vineyard owner, God has watered the vineyard of his chosen ones and given them all they need. He led them out of Egypt, guided them through the Red Sea and gave them the Promised Land. What return do they make? They turned from The Lord and worshipped other gods. They lacked courage to be true to Him and forgot all He had done.

Much has been given to us through the gift of Jesus' Death on the Cross and His Resurrection. So, as we are busy about so many good things in life and challenged by many others, it is good for us to turn to the Lord and ask for his help with all that life throws at us each day. A very good way to do that is through the intercession of Mary, His Mother.

October, in our Catholic tradition, is a month dedicated to the Holy Rosary, a beautiful devotion to Mary, Mother of God. The rosary is an excellent prayer which takes only about fifteen minutes to pray. It is a way to remember all we have is from God and we should turn to him with our needs. Mary will intercede for us and, it's hard for God to say "no" to his Mother.
