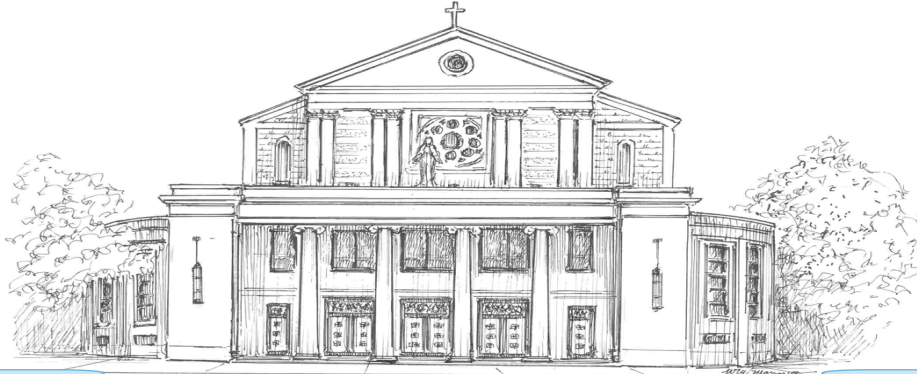

Tuition Scholarship Reminder

This is a good time to remind the parents and guardians of our children who attend Catholic Schools that we will be issuing applications for the parish scholarships in the next few weeks for the 2016-2017 school year. The requirement for the \$850 tuition scholarship is as follows:

The scholarship will be granted to *Active Parishioners only*. An active parishioner is one who attends Mass weekly and contributes to the financial support of the parish on a weekly basis.

If you and your child do not attend Mass, then you are in jeopardy of not receiving the scholarship for the next school year. More information will be mailed to your home in the next few weeks. There will be no partial scholarships offered this year.
