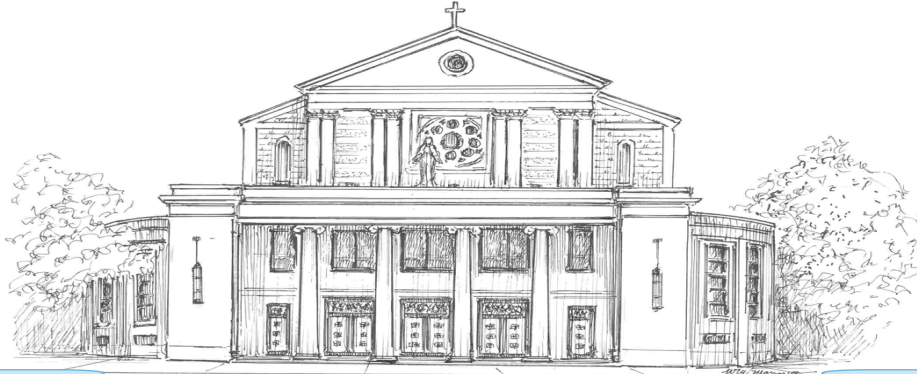

### REVEREND ALFONSO J. CONCHA (Fr. AI) CDR CHC USN- Ret

Father Al Concha was born in Ecuador and graduated from St. Peter Pasqual HS. He attended the Catholic University of Ecuador and obtained a Certificate in Philosophy.

In 1972 he attended Saint Charles Borromeo Seminary in Overbrook, Philadelphia, PA where he earned a Bachelor of Arts in Philosophy 1974 and Master of Divinity 1976. Father Al was ordained a priest for the Archdiocese of Philadelphia 15 May 1976. He served in several Parishes: St Bonaventure 1976-1978, Cathedral SS Peter and Paul 1978-1983, St John Bosco Hatboro 1983-1988, St Mark Bristol 1988-1991.

Additional Education includes 1976-1977 Graduate Studies in Counseling, Villanova University PA; 1994-1995 Graduate Studies on Pastoral Counseling, University of San Diego CA; 1991-2011 Military training and Chaplain's school education 2008-2010. He attended general studies University of Maryland Sigonella Italy; 2010 initiated Theological studies for STL in Spirituality, S. Paul School Catania, Italy.

In 1991, Father Concha was released from the Archdiocese to serve as a Navy Chaplain. Attended the Chaplain's school in Newport RI and was assigned for duty 2nd Marine Air Wing, Cherry Point, NC. He completed selective passenger qualifications and Cold Weather Survival training during exercise Alpine Warrior '92. He then deployed to Northern NATO exercises to Norway during exercise Battle Griffin 1992 and 1993. He deployed to Turkey in support of Teamwork and Display Determination '93 and Cope Thunder'93 Eielson AFB, Alaska. From 1994 to May 1996, Father Concha served as the PHIBRON ONE Chaplain, San Diego, CA. He deployed on a WESTPAC 1995 and 1996 aboard USS PELELIU (LHA 5) in support of Iron Magic/Iron Siren and Eastern Maverick exercises. Then, he reported to the US Naval Hospital, Okinawa Japan 1996-1999. From July 1999 to September 2001 he served as the Flight Line Chaplain, NAS Corpus Christi, TX. From October 2001 to November 2003 he served aboard the USS JOHN C. STENNIS (CVN 74) where he deployed on a WESTPAC 2001 and 2002 in support of Operation ENDURING FREEDOM. He then transferred to NAVSUPFAC Diego Garcia December 2003 until January 2005. In Feb 2005 he moved to MCAS Iwakuni Japan until Nov 2006. From December 2006 to November 2008 Commander Concha served and deployed with the 31st Marine Expeditionary Unit, Okinawa Japan. Father Al reported to NAS Sigonella, Italy in December 2008 till 2011 as Command Chaplain.

Father Al Concha became a US Navy Commander and has received military awards including Navy Meritorious Service Medal, Commendation Medal (8), Navy Expeditionary Medal, Armed Forces Expeditionary Medal, Global War on Terrorism Expeditionary Medal, Global War on Terrorism Service Medal, and various service and unit awards. Commander Concha retired from US Navy June 2011.

Fr. Al served at St. Francis de Sales Church in Philadelphia PA July and August 2011 and then attended a Priests' training at the North American College in Rome. He reported to St Matthew Parish December 17, 2011 where he served until June 2012. On Jun 30, 2012 he became Pastor of St. Agnes Church in West Chester PA. Fr. Al Concha was assigned as Administrator to St. Bridget's Church East Falls Philadelphia on January 18, 2016 till present.
