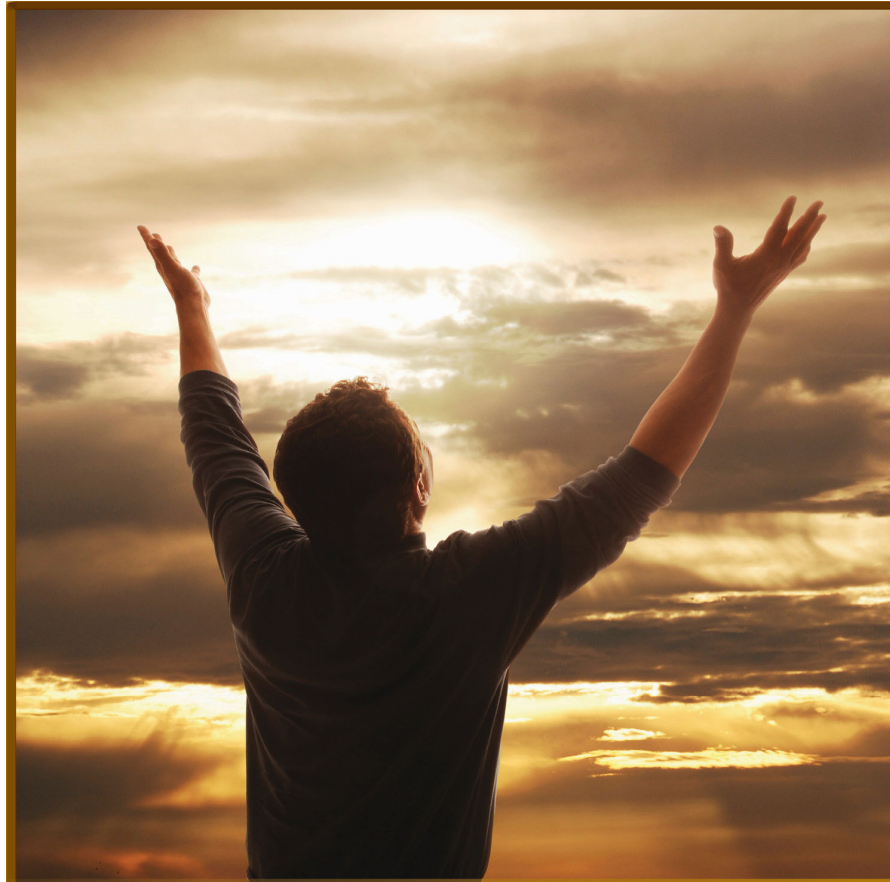


Thirty-Second Sunday in Ordinary Time

Thirty-Second Sunday in Ordinary Time November 12, 2017

FOCUS: Today, as we hear about the kingdom of heaven, we are reminded to be steadfast in our Christian faith, hope and love.

Jesus uses a parable to teach us about the reality of heaven. He warns us not to become drowsy in our faith, like the virgins who in their foolish lack of preparation bring no oil with them. Instead, Jesus teaches that we are to live in such a way that we are ready to meet the Lord.

LITURGY OF THE WORD: The first reading reminds us that wisdom is found by those who desire and seek her. The second reading exhorts us to live buoyed by the hope of eternal life in heaven. In the Gospel, Jesus tells the parable of the ten virgins, which reminds us of the importance of staying awake for we do not know the day or hour Jesus will return.

We welcome Seminarian Roneld St. Louis who will speak about VOCATIONS to the priesthood.

40 HOURS AT ST. WILLIAM - Preacher is Fr. Callaghan

Ordained a priest in 1976, Fr. Michael Callaghan professed his final vows as a Vincentian in 1985 where he found the communal life for which he was seeking in the Congregation of the Mission. A native of Olney and a graduate of Cardinal Dougherty, Fr. Callaghan earned a BA in Philosophy and a MDiv in Theology at St. Charles Seminary as well as a PhD in English from NYU. He began his ministry to the priesthood at Sacred Heart in Havertown and also served at Our Lady of Fatima in Bensalem. Fr. Callaghan taught English at Archbishop Wood and was an Assistant Professor of English and Speech at St. John's University for which he received the Outstanding Faculty Achievement Award in 2002. He also served as Chair of the Department of English at St. Joseph's Preparatory Seminary in Princeton, NJ. After 33 years of teaching he took a sabbatical in 2014, which turned into a new assignment as pilgrimage director at the Miraculous Medal Shrine where he currently serves.
